

## Installing Windows 1.0.2 Update

This lesson will show you how to install the Virtual Historian: Doctrine & Covenants 1.0.2 update from our website. This example uses Internet Explorer 7 to download the installer from our website.

**IMPORTANT:** Make sure that you quit Virtual Historian before attempting to install the update.

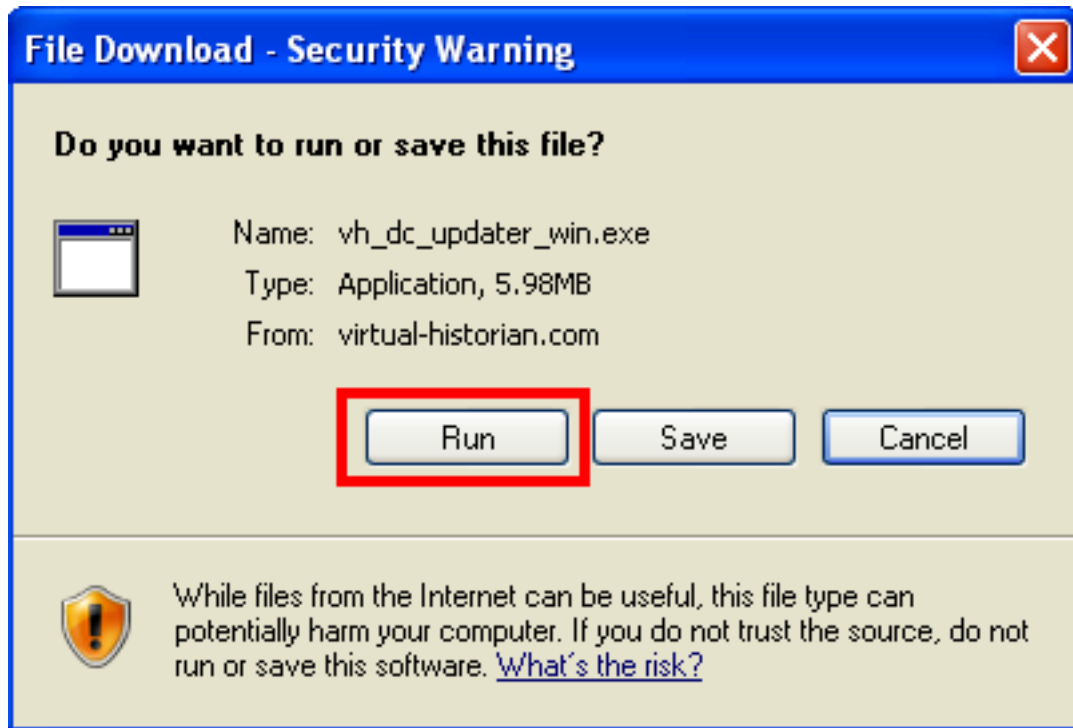
Click on the "Download" link below to download the Virtual Historian: Doctrine & Covenants quit Virtual Historian: Doctrine & Covenants before running the installer.

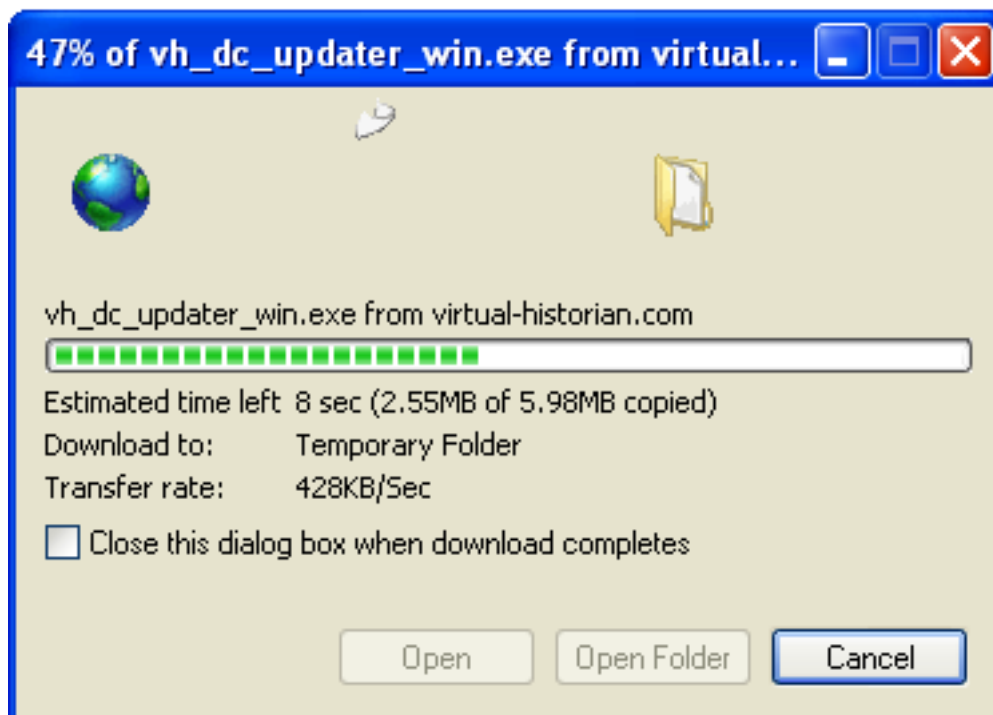
Self-Extracting Archive by clicking on the **Download** link.

Run vh\_dc\_updater\_win.exe

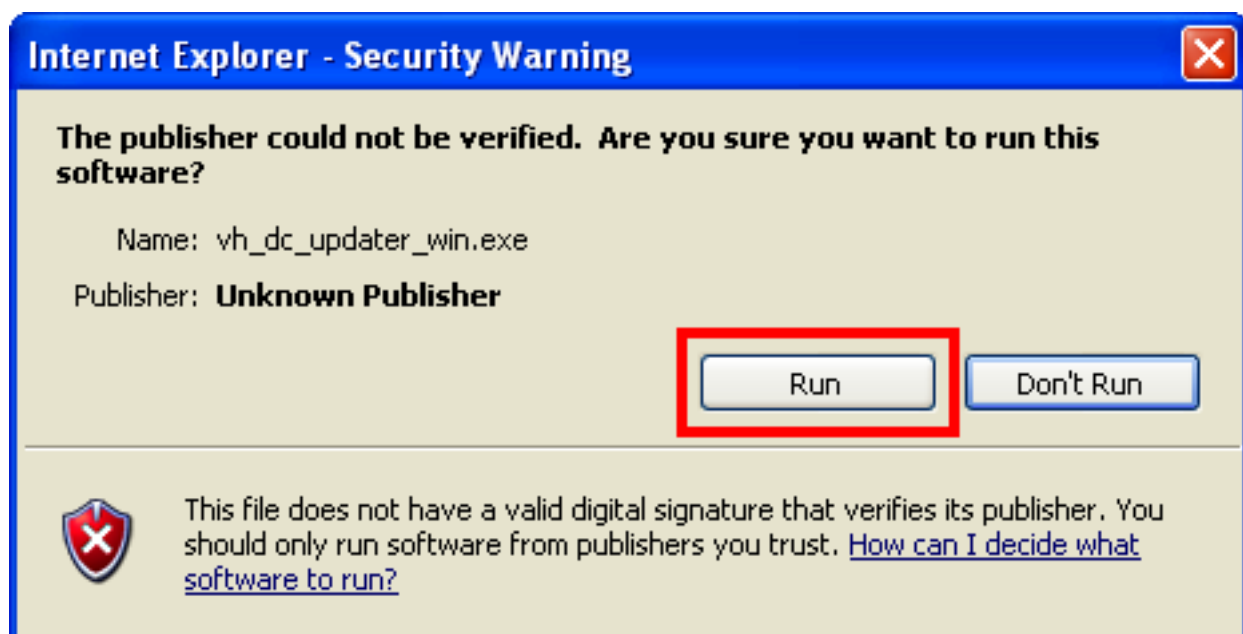


Your browser will prompt you to **Run** or **Save** the file. Click on **Run**.

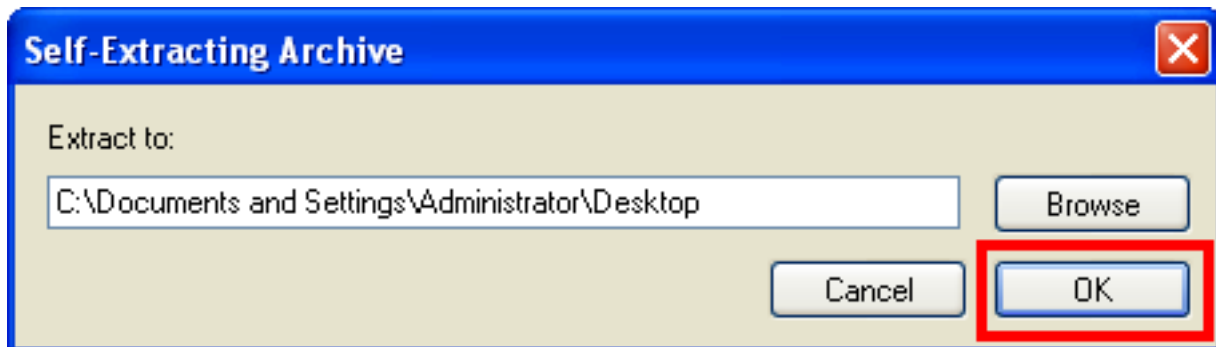
## Installer Will Download



## Confirm That You Want To Run vh\_dc\_updater\_win.exe

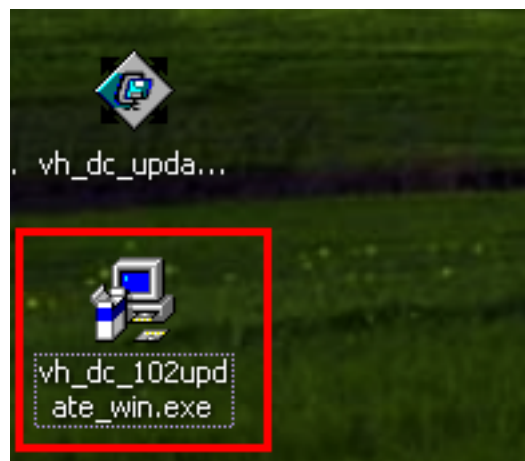


## Select Destination for Updater



You will now be prompted for a location to store the Virtual Historian updater. In this example I am going to place the updater on the Desktop. Click the **OK** button.

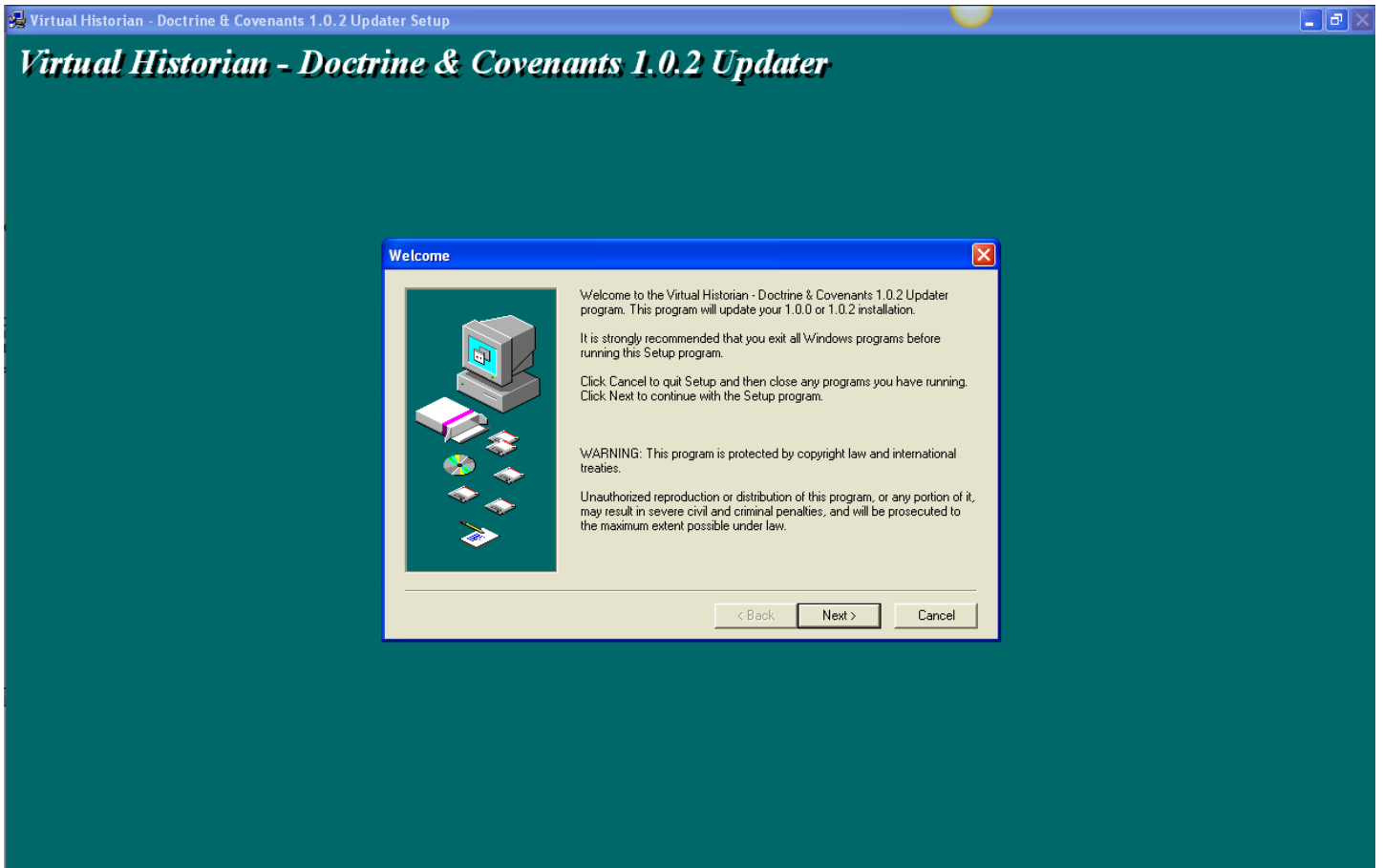
## Launch Updater



A file named `vh_dc_102update_win.exe` should now be located on your Desktop. Double-click on the file to launch the updater.

**IMPORTANT:** Make sure that you quit Virtual Historian before running the updater.

## Follow Prompts



You will now be guided through the update process.

## Cleanup



You can delete the `vh_dc_updater_win.exe` file **(1)** from your computer. You can also delete the `vh_dc_102update_win.exe` file **(2)** if you wish; or you can keep the updater on your computer in

case you ever need to reinstall Virtual Historian: Doctrine & Covenants in the future.
